

ADSB, EDGE Entity, to Build 12m and 16m Fast Patrol Boats for CICPA in AED 175 Million Deal

EDGE entity [Abu Dhabi Ship Building](#) (ADSB), the regional leader in the design, build, maintenance, repair, refit, and conversion of naval and commercial vessels, announced that it has been awarded an AED 175 million contract to build its [120 Fast Inshore Platform \(FIP\)](#) and 160 Inshore Tactical Engagement Platform (ITEP) for the Critical Infrastructure & Coastal Protection Authority (CICPA). Announced at the Naval Defence & Maritime Security Exhibition (NAVDEX 2023) which is held alongside International Defence Exhibition and Conference (IDEX 2023), the deal marks the first local order of the company's UAE-made vessels which are expertly-designed for both near shore rescue and extended search and rescue (SAR) missions.

David Massey, CEO of ADSB said: "Having worked closely with CICPA to design the tactical and sophisticated vessels they need to carry out their critical duties, we are delighted to see our relationship with them strengthen and expand, and we express our gratitude for their unwavering trust in our solutions.
