

UAE Cyber Security Council and EDGE Entity ORYXLABS Sign MoU to Strengthen Information Security Efforts



Dubai, United Arab Emirates: 17 October 2024 - EDGE entity ORYXLABS, a leading provider of digital risk protection and [advanced cyber solutions](#), signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the UAE Cyber Security Council, the government body responsible for protecting critical infrastructure and national assets from cyber threats at GITEX Global 2024, being held in the Dubai World Trade Centre (DWTC) until 18 October.
